Citizen's independence, freedom of expression directly linked to good policing, says Shah

NEW DELHI, SEPT 4 /--/ Union home minister Amit Shah today said the most important thing in a democracy is a citizen's independence and freedom of expression which is directly linked to good policing, and this needs to be continuously improved.

Shah said 'beat constable' deployed at the lowest level of the police system makes the "biggest contribution" towards making a democracy successful by protecting the common man. Delivering the keynote speech during the 51st foundation day event of the Bureau of Police Research and Development (BPR&D), the minister said democracy cannot be successful if law and order is not good. "Democracy is our nature... this was our character even before independence and we accepted this after gaining

freedom. This is the nature of our people. The biggest thing in a democracy is a person's independence and freedom of expression," he said.

When it comes to freedom of expression of a person, it is directly linked to law and order, the home minister noted. "Democracy is not just about voting for parties and forming a government... this is just a part of the system. What is the success or fruit of democracy? The fruit is that 130 crore people of the country, according to their capabilities and intelligence, get to develop themselves

and the country gets the benefit of this cumulative effect for its development," Shah said. He emphasised that democracy cannot prosper if law and order in a country is not good. "This work is done by police and forces that guard our borders. It is very important for a successful democracy that the security of a person is ensured. The citizen should keep getting his legal rights in an uninterrupted manner. A citizen should be able to discharge his duties as per the spirit of the constitution," the Union minister stated.

Kerala's mainstream parties vying to support Taliban: State BJP chief

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM, SEPT 4 /--/ BJP state president K Surendran on Saturday alleged that mainstream political parties in Kerala are vying to extend support to Taliban after the terrorist group took control over Afghanistan. Both the ruling CPM-led LDF and the Congress-headed UDF opposition were playing a different sort of politics after the militants were back in power in the neighbouring country, he

charged. He further alleged that those who take a pro-Taliban stand were the ones trying to whitewash the Moplah riots that occurred in the state in 1921. "In Kerala, mainstream political parties are vying with each other to extend support to the Taliban. Political leaders in the state are nurturing religious extremism by giving milk and honey," Surendran said here in a press meet. Attacking the Left

And hence, he said, upgrading and improving police force is the work of BPR&D. Shah noted that the image of police, at certain times, is maligned by certain quarters. "I do not know why a campaign has been run to damage the image of police. Some incidents are hyped and shown, while good incidents are not popularised," the home minister said. He further said while various other institutions like the parliament, state assemblies, judiciary, election commission, CAG and vigilance commission have made democracy successful, the beat constable of police deserved a far greater appreciation in this context. "Not because I am the home minister, but I have had this thinking since my childhood that to make democracy successful, the biggest contribution is of the beat constable," he said.

Without reviving beat policing, basic policing cannot be good and this has to be updated which requires technology upgradation and BPR&D needs to work on that, the minister noted. "I want to say it again that the most difficult job in the government service is that of a policeman," he reiterated. During all festivals, whether it is Holi, Deepwali or Eid, policemen are on duty, he said. "There are no fixed work

hours, neither a definite scope of work for a policeman. I have seen that all this takes a toll on their health and there is no acknowledgement of these things.... the sacrifices made by police personnel is not mentioned much," the minister raved. He asked the BPR&D to give "special focus" and work on the image building of police.

The police should change their work style as per the challenge, he said, counting cyber attacks, drone attacks, narcotics smuggling, fake currency and hawalas as the "biggest" challenges for the security establishment. "For all this, you (BPR&D) should prepare our forces and also study the best practices across the globe," he said. The skills of the cops should be sharpened, Shah said. The minister also talked about reforms done by the Modi government and various steps taken to empower the law enforcement agencies. "The home ministry is doing a number of things to bring about radical changes in the IPC, CrPC and the Evidence Act," he said. Interaction has been held in this context with at least 14 states, three UTs, eight central police organisations, six CAPFs and 7 NGOs; and they have sent in their suggestions. "This is a work in progress... this is a big work," he added. (PTI)

While the CPM has described the rebellion as the most organised agitation against the exploitation by feudal landlords, the Congress has called it a shining movement against the anti-imperialist forces. Vice-Prez calls for fighting against divisive forces

HYDERABAD, SEPT 4 /--/ Vice-President M Venkaiah Naidu on Saturday called upon the people to fight against divisive forces that seek to divide society on the lines of religion, region, language, caste, creed or colour.

In the 75th year of the country's Independence, every Indian must take a pledge to further strengthen unity and harmony in the country's hugely diverse society, he said. Naidu, who was addressing the students and teachers of Sri Aurobindo International School here after inaugurating a photo-exhibition on the life of Sri Aurobindo, emphasised that bridging all divisions was necessary for the greatness of India's future. Highlighting the positive aspects of religion, he said if everyone follows one's religion in true spirit, there will not be any religious conflict, an official release said.

Responding to a student's question, he said reforms were needed in the United Nations so that it becomes a truly representative organisation where the soul and heart of the nations come together. Expressing disapproval of some nationalisms to consider themselves superior to others, he said equal respect for all is a prerequisite to bring unity of mankind. "Separate identities are going to be there but these identities should not divide us," he said. Reiterating Sri Aurobindo's vision for India's spirituality, Naidu said a reawakening needs to come about in terms of the country's rich legacy of spiritual wisdom which would need to be recast into new forms and expressions to make it globally relevant and in keeping with the contemporary times.

Observing that Bharat Mata needs to delve deep into her own treasures, he exhorted the country's youth to be independent and original in their thinking, drawing upon native sources instead of being content as poor imitators of the West. He called for rewriting Indian history with an Indian perspective to instill a sense of pride in "our glorious cultural heritage among the younger generation." Naidu said GDP growth and wealth creation are not an end in themselves, rather they are means to bring happiness in people's lives which should be the ultimate aim. Describing Sri Aurobindo as a great revolutionary Yogi, philosopher, poet and freedom fighter, Naidu said he remains an eternal source of inspiration for every Indian. (PTI)
